Prophetic Revelation

THE TWO HOLY CITIES TO COME

My beloved brethren, as we all know, the apostle Yokhanan [John] recorded for posterity in the book of Revelation that the eternal dwelling place of Abba YAH and Messiah Yahushua is the Holy City, New Jerusalem. And according to the prophecy, there will not be a temple in the New City. As it is written, "But I saw no temple in it, for the LORD GOD Almighty and the Lamb are its temple" (Rev. 21:22).

Now, the prophet Yechezqel [Ezekiel] *also* received a revelation about a New City. But the Holy City he foresaw *includes* a new temple. And as the prophet wrote, "And He said to me, 'Son of man, this is the place of My throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Yisrael forever" (Ezek 43:7). This ancient prophecy from 'Ezekiel' reveals that Abba YAH Himself will dwell in this new temple, located in a New City.

So how is it then, my brethren? Are there actually two eternal Holy Cities prophesied to come?

To begin with, throughout Ezekiel's prophecy, the new city he recorded is never referred to as New Jerusalem! However, a divine name for the new city is included in the prophecy. As the prophet wrote, "...the name of the city from that day shall be: 'YAHUWAH is there'" (Ezek. 48:35). So then, the name of the Holy City to be built in the original Promised Land will be Yahushámah, rather than Yerushalayim! SÉLAH. The prophecy also specifies that this New Eternal City – *which includes a Temple* – will be built somewhere in the land originally allotted to the twelve tribes of Yisrael. And according to the blueprint the prophet received, the New City in eretz Yisrael will be 122.5 miles long on each side, creating a four hundred ninety-mile perimeter.

The state of Israel as it currently exists is about ninety miles wide at its broadest point. So obviously, the Temple Mount, and even the entire "Old City," even if the ancient City of Davïd to the south were included, is not nearly large enough to contain the city revealed to Ezekiel. Surely, brethren, the state of Israel as we know it today cannot be the land Ezekiel envisioned. And surely, the enormous Holy City recorded by John in the book of Revelation cannot be the same city described by Ezekiel...

Now notice, saints, that the city John saw *was not specifically assigned to the original Promised Land!* Also notice that historically speaking, in the 'New World,' the United States of America is literally 'The Land of the New.'

For example, cities and states whose names include the word 'New' are a recurring theme across America – as in New York, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Orleans and so on; with most names being taken from a city or state in the 'Old World' of the Eastern Hemisphere. And needless to say, the U.S. is far and away the preeminent power in the 'New World.'

Behold: According to the Hebrew tongue as currently spoken in the state of Israel, and in keeping with the historical purpose of America, the Israeli School System teaches its students that 'Arzareth'-America is "The Land of the New Promise" or "The Land of the New Covenant."

Finally, brethren, will the New Jerusalem seen by Yokhanan-John in the Revelation exist in a different time period than the new Holy City recorded in Ezekiel? Sensationalized eschatology says an unequivocal yes. But – could it be that there will be *two* eternal Holy Cities, with one in eretz Yisrael, and one in 'The New Promised Land' of America?

Undoubtedly, the "\$64,000,000 question" among Hebrew Yisraelites for 2021 and beyond shall be: <u>Is southwest America the true location of New Jerusalem?</u> SÉLAH.
